EXTERNAL FUNDRAISING POLICY

- 1 The Trustees will only give permission for fundraising activities on KLCF premises for charities or good causes whose vision is consistent with that of KLCF or is at the very least not incompatible
- 2 The Trustees reserve the right to refuse the use of the premises for any proposed fundraising event.
- 3 Decisions in relation to paragraphs 1 and 2 of this policy must be agreed by at least two Elders or Trustees
- 4 No expectation should be placed upon anyone to help with organising, running or supporting any fundraising event and no church member or attender should be made to feel in any way that they must participate.
- 5 No expectation should be placed upon KLCF employees to attend, to open, close or clean the building; organisers may be required to reimburse the church for any such costs incurred.
- 6 Any use of the building must be under the terms of our Hire Policy.
- 7 Premises must be left in good condition.
